

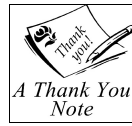

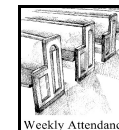
Best wishes to newlyweds Jennifer Cascarino and Brandon Reith who were married in our Sanctuary on June 26th.

Moravian Daily Texts for 2011

With the opening of each year, Moravian families begin reading the new edition of the *Moravian Daily Texts* or *Daily Texts* as it is familiarly called.

The *Losungen* or *Daily Texts* was first published in 1731. As such the Moravian Church has been a pioneer in the publication of a book for use in public and private devotions. Even today in many countries in Europe, the *Daily Texts* is the only such devotional book available. Worldwide, more than 1.5 million copies of the *Daily Texts* are printed in 51 languages and dialects, from German and Czech to Tibetan, Zulu to Inuktitut. The number of readers cannot be stated even approximately, but it is used by members of other denominations as well as by Moravians.

This year the Church Office is asking members to order their 2011 *Daily Texts* by contacting the Office before July 19, 2010. This will allow a more accurate number of copies to be ordered, without over-ordering.

The prices will be:

- Paperback - \$9.00
- Large Print - \$11.00
- Hard Cover - \$13.00

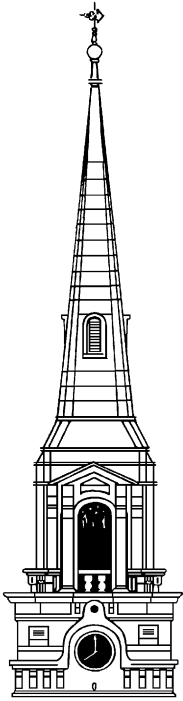
